County North Carolina being of sound mind perfect memory
do this Eighth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and twenty six make and publish this my last
Will and Testament in manner following that is to say
First I give and bequeath to my wife Stabell a full and entire the Land
where on I now live containing one hundred and seventy five acres
during her life or Widowhood, but if she thinks proper to marry
and manys: she is to have but one third of the Land laid off
in the lower part including the Houses wherein I now live
during her life time; after her death to be equally divided
among my Children then living — I also give and bequeath
to my wife Stabell a Negro man named Hannan during
her life or Widowhood (but if she marries he is to be hers
and

She is to have but an equal part as one of my Children. If he does not Oby her to help her to raise the family then my will is that my executor shall sell him and purchase such slave as she and my executor may think best. The remainder of my property I also give and bequeath to my wife Isabella to enable her to raise and school the Children except so much as she and my executor think proper to sell to pay my debts and other use for the family and all Monies arising in any manner from my estate to be equally divided among my Children when the youngest becomes of age And I hereby make and declare my Brother John Glover executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Francis Glover have to this my last will and Testament Set my hand and seal the say one year above written
