 The following is my last Will and testament -
 1st I direct my Executor herein after named to pay all my
 Just debts & burial expense - 2nd My Wife Mary to have full
 possession of my whole Estate whatever during her widowhood
 and in case she marries one half of the personal existing
 at that period at her Death or Marriage to sell the whole
 Estate and Divide as follows - 3rd to George son of Simon
 Rutbottom one hundred Dollars 4th Ezekiel Mazy twenty
 Dollars - and his sister Ann ten Dollars 5th to Robert Quinn
 Daughter Mary & Hannah each ten Dollars 6th To my
 Legatee now named the residue of my Estate to be
 divided in portions as follow - To Phebe Rutbottom nine
 shares, to Joshua Dixon six shares, to the Children of
 my Brother Enoch Dixon namely Sarah & Amor each
 one share - To the Children of my Brother Caleb Dixon
 namely Ann, Susanna, Dinah, Rebecca, Hannah, Enoch
 Jonathan, Daniel, George and Mary each one share
 I appoint Simon Rutbottom & Stephen White to execute

of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina
being of sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed
be God) do make and publish this as my last will and
testament in manner and form as following. (to wit).
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy McRae
negroes, Bond and her child together with all and every
description of property which has hitherto been given in
her possession - I then I hereby confirm the gift to my son
Franklin of the land whereon he lives and all other property
which I have hitherto given and delivered him. I then I
hereby confirm the gift to my son Leslie Kelly of the land
whereon he lives and all other property which I have
hitherto given and delivered him. I then I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Polly L. Billo a negro girl named
Faty together with all and every description of property
which has hitherto been given in her possession -
I then I give and bequeath to my four Daughters, Lucinda
Kelly, Sinny Kelly, Aurilia Kelly and Velena B. Kelly
the sum of two hundred Dollars each to be paid them
by my Executors (hereafter named) when they shall marry
and it is my further wish in this bequest that if in the
opinion of my Executors upon consultation with my
Wife that a larger sum can be spared them enough
should be paid each to buy a negro girl each -
