mind and memory, be judge God do this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June in the  
year of our Lord Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and  
thirty three, make and publish this my last will and  
Testament in manner following that is to say, I wish & my will  
to be Equally divided betwix my beloved wife <sup>my wife</sup> and children  
that is to say Thomas H, Mary A, Philip A, Eliza and  
Sophia M, and George W, also I wish my land to be sold and  
on such notice as my Executor may think best, and all of my  
personal property, to be sold except the waggon and what  
Horses will be sufficient to remove them to the western  
Country, and be equally divided between the same above  
named persons. I wish all my debts to be paid out of the above  
property, I hereby make and ordain my friend Green Hornack  
my Executor of this my last will and Testament for which  
whereof the said George W Taylor have to this my last will  
and Testament set my hand and the day and year above written,  
Signed sealed published and declared  
by the said Geo. W Taylor the Testator  
as his last will and Testament in the  
presence of us who present at the  
signing and sealing thereof
