being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory
thank be to Almighty God do make and ordain
this my last Will and Testament in the manner following

1st I bind to my beloved wife Daphne Williams that

part of the tract of land on which I now live lying
on the north side of the Indian branch also the one
fourth part of my Grist Mill also my beds and furniture
one beehive. One lead table, three chairs in the house, two
work horses three cows and calves two sows & piggs also
a negro man by the name of Allen and a boy by the
name of Macklin one woman by the name of Anna
and one girl by the name of Nelly and one by the
name of Phoebe. Also that part of the Cleared land
that I purchased of George Barber lying on the west
side of the road also one years provision all of the
above mentioned property I bind to her her natural
life or widowhood and after her death or intermarriage
that part of the land wherein I now live that I lent to
her to return to Marmaduke Williams as also the one fourth
part of my grist mill to return to Marmaduke
Williams and that part of the George Barber tract
which I lent to her to return to John Williams the
residue after her death to be sold and divided up
by amongst William Williams, Richd Williams
Elizabeth Moore Martha Stone Elmy Williams
John Williams the lawful heirs of George Williams
viz Eliza David P. John S and Polly E Williams
and Marmaduke Williams

I give and bequeath to John Williams the tract of

I purchased of George Barber and half of my mill & site
also one negro man by the name of Major

3rd I give to my son Marmaduke Williams the land I purchased
of Simon Williams and also the tract I purchased of Henry
Kelly and the one half of saw mill and one fourth of
part of my grist mill & site and one negro man by the name
of Morris. The above mentioned property which I have
given to John & Marmaduke Williams is to and their heirs
forever

It is my will that my daughters Picti Williams Elizabeth
Moore Paley Stone & Henry Williams keep what I have
given them before It is also my will that my Williams shall
receive out of my estate the sum of one hundred and twenty
dollars it being about the amount which he had to pay
Chris Barber as security to George Williams it was done
by my request as to the residue of my estate after paying all
my just debts It is my will that it should be divided
amongst my daughters Picti Williams Elizabeth Moore
Paley Stone Henry Williams John Williams Marmaduke
Williams & the lawful heirs of George Williams Junr viz
Eliza Sarah P John & Polly Williams who are
to be considered equal to one Legatee

And I moreover appoint John Williams Henry Williams
& William Williams executors to this my last will and
testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
seal This 20th February A.D. 1833
