this my last Will and Testament in the manner follow-
ing

1st I bequeath to my beloved wife Delpha Williams that
part of the tract of land on which I now live ly-
ing on the north side of the Indian branch also the
fourth part of my grist mill also my beds and furniture
one beffel. one leaf table the chair in the house three
work horses three cows and calves two sows & pigs also
a negro man by the name of Allen and a boy by the
name of Madelin one woman by the name of Phillis
and one girl by the name of Niddy and one by the
name of Phoebe Also that part of the cleared land
that I purchased of George Barber lying on the west
side of the road also one years provision all of the
above mentioned property I bequeath to her her natural
life or widowhood and after her decease or intermarriage
that part of the land whereon I now live that I lent to
her to return to Marmaduke Williams as also the one
fourth part of my grist mill to return to Marmaduke
Williams and that part of the George Barber tract
which I lent to her to return to ~~return~~ John Williams the
the residue after her decease to be sold and divided
by amongst William Williams, Rich^d Williams
Elizabeth Moore Martha Stone Ginny Williams
John Williams the lawful heirs of George Williams
viz Elya David P. John H and Polly E Williams
and Marmaduke Williams
2nd I give & convey to John Williams the tract of

I purchased of George Barber and half of my mill & site
also one negro man by the name of Major
3rd I give to my son Marmaduke Williams the land I purchased
of Simon Williams and also the tract I purchased of Henry
Kelly and the one half of saw mill and one fourth of
part of my grist mill & site and one negro man by the name
of Morris. The above mentioned property which I have
given to John & Marmaduke Williams is to and their heirs
forever

It is my will that Impe Williams Dick Williams Elizabeth
Moore Patsy Stone & Henry Williams keep what I have
given them before It is also my will that Wm Williams shall
receive out of my estate the sum of one hundred and twenty
dollars it being about the amount which he had to pay
Chris Barber as security to George Williams it was done
by my request. as to the residue of my estate after paying all
my last debts It is my will that it should be divided
amongst Wm Williams Dick Williams Elizabeth Moore
Patsy Stone Henry Williams John Williams Marmaduke
Williams & the lawful heirs of George Williams Junr viz
Eliza David P John & Polly Williams who are
to be considered equal to one Legatee

And I moreover appoint John Williams Henry Williams
& William Williams executors to this my last will and
