

Item 4th is my will & desire that my Executor hereafter named shall with the assistance of two good men provide that 5 of said estate & collected up, to divide my said estate in a other words the proceeds equally amongst all of my children by my last wife Viz. Maria Ann Perry, Wm Benson Perry, John Hunter Perry, Henry Clay Perry, George Perry, and Joseph John Wesley Perry.

5th Item - It is my will and desire that my aforesaid wife Elizabeth should manage for my youngest child should arrive at full age that she receive a full and equal share of my estate - or on my youngest child coming of age in the life time of my said wife Elizabeth then it is my will & desire that she my said wife Elizabeth, share & share equally with my aforesaid children. All of this my aforesaid will is intended to exclude all my children by my first wife, and give all my estate of every kind to my last wife Elizabeth and her children and none others.

6th Item - I hereby nominate and appoint my worthy, and trusted in tie friend Turner Brynnum my sole & lawful executor, to carry this my last will & Testament into effect -

In the name of God Amen I Hannah Edwards being of sound mind but of a weak body and the least of my late very uncertain do make this my last will & Testament as comes to be made, I do want my Executor to provide a burial suitable to my children wish and to pay all of my just debts of whatever nature

I give to my two girls all of my house hold property to divide equally between Malinda Edwards & Martha Williams, I also give Malinda Edwards one cow & calf Martha she has had none

I give to my two girls & two boys an equal share in the land but my two girls is to have the houses that is on the plantation James Edwards and Thomas is to be free at my death

4th James is to have the young cattle & Thomas of his sheep is to have a cattle by buying it

5th of Malinda never has no more children her part of the land is to go to Martha Williams and the half of her body provided she takes care of her and also Martha Williams there is to go to her and the half of her body and if Martha Williams cannot take in the house with Malinda Edwards she can hold if she chooses

6th I leave my young Slaves to the care of
 J Malendus for their powers on the farm
 Malendus is to give the boys a bed a piece
 & I ~~will~~ give my Executor leave to sell all
 such property as can best be spared off the farm
 to pay my debts If my children were proved for
 the same and if the will I leave my Executor
 no other trouble than to hold this my will as
 a copy of it and see that it is faithfully carried out

one hundred dollars to each of them within two years
after my death then I confirm the gift of said Negroes
to the said Endly Council and Michael Throckmole
to be equally divided between them to them & their heirs
forever.
I then I give and bequeath to Brother Simon Simon
all the rest of my property (not here before given
away to him and his heirs forever

I then and lastly I do hereby constitute
constitute and appoint my trusty friend George
Johnson my Executor to this my last will
overriding all other by me made and acknowledged
this and this only to be my last will & testament
in manner and form as above stated

of Feb in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & forty nine
