one horse Colt & one sixth part of the present crop
that is now growing I give to My daughter Mary
Jane Foorher one ~~Bedroom~~ ^{ward} one bed & furniture &
My riding saddle I give to My son Joseph George Foorher
I give one bed & furniture & one Mahogany Table I
give to My son Ambrose Foorher My bible -
I give to My four daughters to wit Abigail Hannah
Fanny & Eliza Foorher two folding Tables three dressing
Tables all My sitting chairs one Clock all My Lugs a pair
of Brass Candlesticks & all the ballances of My house hold
furniture also My kitchen furniture to be divided equally
between the four I give the rest of My property of every
description I give to all My Children to be equally divided
between them to wit John William Ambrose Charles Joseph
Elizabeth Nancy Abigail Anna Hannah Fanny Mary
& Eliza except the corn Wheat Bacon and such other
articles of provisions I wish to remain on the plantation for
the support of family & stock the present year and
I hereby appoint My son John Foorher My executor of this
My last will & testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set My hand & seal the day & date above written
signed & sealed in presence of us

 One thousand eight hundred and twenty three Make and
 publish this My last will and testament in manner following
 that is to say first My will is that all My just debts be
 paid I And unto My beloved wife Fanny Po All
 all the land and plantation during her life time
 I give and bequeath unto My wife the following things
 viz One feather bed and furniture One cow and calf
 One sow and pig all the Corn and bacon One fine
 chest two pots One Dutch Oven One spinning wheel
 My earthen ware and later all My silver Churn
 Item I give unto My son Austin Po five shillings
 I give unto My daughter Polly Jones five shillings
 My daughter Elizabeth Harty five shillings I give unto My
 daughter Sarah Smith five shillings I give unto My
 daughter Ann Puckey five shillings I give unto My
 daughter Haffy Po One feather bed and furniture
 One scarves loom I give and bequeath unto My

daughter Susan Po One feather bed and furniture
 One black walnut chest I give and bequeath unto My
 son Stephen Po One bag Some One sheep One sow and
 pig I give and bequeath unto My son William Po
 One gray horse One bed and furniture One cow and
 yearling One sow and pig My will is that after the
 death of My wife that My lands be equally divided
 between My three youngest sons Namely Reuben, Stephen
 and William Po My will further is that after the
 death of My wife all the personal property that I have
 left her be sold and equally divided between Haffy
 Po Stephen Po Susan Po, Reuben Po, Stephen Po &
 William Po My will further is that My debts be collected and
 all the balance of My estate that is not will away
 be sold and all My just debts be paid and the
 balance after paying My debts be equally divided
 between My wife Fanny My son Reuben My daughter
 Haffy My daughter Stephen My son Stephen and My
 son William I hereby Make and Ordain My son Reuben
 Po executor of this My last will and testament In
 witness whereof the said Stephen Po have to this My last
 will and testament Set My hand and seal the day
 and year above written signed sealed published and
 delivered by the said Stephen Po the testator as his last
 will and testament in the presence of us who were present
 at the time signing and sealing thereof
