 shall please god to call do make constitute ordain & Declare this my
 Last will & Testament in manner and form following To wit
 and annulling by these presents all previous Testament or Testaments
 Will or wills heretofore by me made and declared Either by word
 or writing and this is to be taken only for my last will & Testament
 and together and now for the settling of my personal estate, which it
 hath pleased god to bestow upon me I do order give Dispose the same
 in manner & form following that is to say first I will that all Debts
 be paid within convenient time after my Decease by my Executors
 hereafter named I Item Give and bequeath to my daughter Bethany
 Rapon one Negro Girl named Ruth and her first living Child to
 Mary Wland Daughter of Bethany Rapon. I Give & bequeath to my
 son Henry Bagley one Negro girl named Jane I Give and bequeath to my
 son Benjamin Bagley one Negro girl named Simon I Give & bequeath
 to my son Jacob Bagley three negroes Sarahah Patrick and Nancy and
 all my land on the north east side of the Meadow Creek to the upper
 Road and all my land on south side of the same Creek up to the Little
 branch below the fork then up the S. branch to the fork then with the North
 fork to the anson Road I Give and bequeath to my son ^{great} ~~John~~ Bagley the
 same five acres and one pecker bed I Give & bequeath to my son ~~John~~
 Elisha Bagley three Negroes named George the Elder Jacob & Lucy
 and all my land on the North side of the anson Road

and the south side of the Meadow Creek & up the said Creek
 to the upper Road then all my land North of that Road with that
 field south of the anson Road & down the Meadow Creek to
 the first branch then up the said branch to the fork then
 with the North fork to the anson Road I will that the
 house hold furniture and stock of all kinds with the House
 hold utensils be Equally Divided Between my two sons Jacob
 & Elisha and they to pay to Stephen Piaver & Miley Edie
 three sons Henry John & James Edie ten pound each
 also I will that the three other Negroes Louis Prefilla
 Catherine & little George be Equally Divided Between
 Henry Benjamin & Bethany Rapon with the Incurance
 fees & and my two sons Jacob & Elisha to pay the Fiddly Item
 I constitute & appoint John Rapon & my son Jacob Bagley
 Executors to this my last will & Testament in full power
 To act as they are Directed by law in such cases as witness my
 hand the day & Date first above written
