R. Stanton his heirs and assigns all my Estate
both Real & personal, In Trust Nevertheless for the
sole & separate use & benefit of my Sister Mrs. Elizabeth
Stiller, for and during the Term of her natural life
from the moment right of her present or
future Husband & after her death to be equally divided
among & between all the children which she now has
or may have hereafter & the child or children
of any child or children of my said Sister that
may die in her lifetime, the child or children
of such deceased child or children of my said
Sister to Represent his her or their ancestor.
