Sarah Newlin having been left a like share by a former Will
and since said as their really Will show it is my Desire that
Deborah Deal and Sarah Newlin be there with Content
I give unto my grand Children to wit my son Robert Holaday Son
Henry likewise Thomas Holaday Daughter Mary likewise my Daughter
Abigail McCrackens Daughter and Son Mary and Henry likewise
Rebekah Henshaw Daughter Mary likewise my son Henry Holaday
son Henry likewise my Daughter Mary Quakenbush son Henry
Each of the above named grand Children the sum of twenty shillings

I give unto my son Robert Holaday son William my big coat my will is
 that such of my Estate as is not already bequeathed and named be Equally Divided
 Between my four sons to wit Samuel Holaday Robert Holaday William Holaday
 and Thomas Holaday More and More a like both Principal and interest
 to this Date and the Interest arising here after to go to my son Thomas for
 his trouble and Expence Lastly I constitute and appoint my son Thomas
 Holaday my sole and Executor of this my last will and testament and I
 do hereby revoke Disavow and disannul all and Every former testimony
 Wills and Legacies Bequests Executors by me in anywise before named written
 or bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last
 Will and testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this third day of August in the year of Lord one Thousand Eight
 Hundred Signed sealed, published
