 I commend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my executor and as touching my
 worldly estate whereunto it has pleased God to bless me in
 this life I give devise and of the same in the following
 manner and form: First I love my Wife my next and
 then I leave unto Anna Hatch my Wife all of my estate
 during of life, and then for my Son to be equal divided
 between Josiah Hatch and James Hatch. I give unto
 my son James Hatch one bed and then unto Josiah
 one Bed, and unto my daughter Mary Hatch one
 Bed; And my further devise is for the first Coll that my
 executors bring for Josiah and the second Coll for Mary
 And my devise is after the death of my Wife is for all the
 rest of my estate to be equal divided between Josiah
 Mary then the 1st day of February 1818
