

I know all persons whom it may concern that I Jane Hadley of the County of Chatham and state of North Carolina being much infirm in body, and knowing the Mortality of all flesh and that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do this second day of the Eleventh Month one thousand eight hundred thirty and two, make and ordain this my last will and testament, and as touching such worldly affairs as it hath pleased the Lord to bless me with, I do will, bequeath, and dispose of in manner following, that is to say first I allow my funeral charges then my just debts to be paid.

Then I will bequeath to esteemed friend & relation Ruth Hadley daughter of Joseph (sixteen dollars cash, I will and bequeath to her sister Anne one case of Drawers, I will and bequeath to their younger sister Rebecca my flax wheel, I will & bequeath unto my four near Relations, namely,) Elizabeth bone Rebecca Micens, Mary Hadley, and Rebecca Hadley, all my deeper furniture to be equally divided among them, likewise all my wearing apparel to be equally divide among the same four abovementioned in case of deeper furniture, And it is my ~~desire~~ will that my two esteemed friends Hannah Andrew and Ruth Nolin to divide both furniture & apparel amongst them to the best of their judgment, I also will and bequeath to my Nephew Stephen Henshaw ten dollars in cash, I nominate and appoint my two esteemed friends Joseph Hadley and William Henshaw executors of this my last will and Testament & do ~~hereby~~ ^{entirely} charge them to act in my

room and in my study in witness whereof ²⁵⁹
