the following manner viz. I lend unto my daugh-
ter Peggy Foster three beds and furniture two chairs
and two Tables during her natural life and at her
Death I will and direct for the above named prop-
erty to be equally divided amongst her surviving
Children I also appoint my friend William Fike
Executor to this my last will and Testament signed
sealed and delivered in the presents of

December the 17th 1835
