

18 In the name of God Amen. This 9th day of July 1819
 I James Booker of the County of ~~...~~ and State of North
 Carolina being very sick in Body but in perfect mind I hereby
 thanks be to Almighty God for it, do make this my last Will
 and Testament the manner and form as follows to wit
 First I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
 that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a
 Christian manner, and touching such worldly goods, which
 it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give &
 dispose of the same in the following manner
 Item I give unto my dearly beloved Wife Phoebe Booker
 the tract of Land I now live on, including that part of the
 Hayes tract, as far as Buck Horse Creek, also four
 Negroes, namely Bob, Abram, Selvy & Pat, one yoke of Steer
 & Cart, half of my dwelling House & other furniture, during
 her life or widowhood, and after ^{her} death to be equally divided
 among my children, also the choice of my Horses, Steer Cows and
 Calves, the last mentioned given to be disposed of as she thinks
 proper. Item, I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved
 son Daniel Booker the tract of Land where he now lives
 on lying in Wake and Cumberland Counties, also one Negro
 Man by the name of Reddick. Item, I give unto my
 dearly beloved son Enoch Booker the tract of Land where
 he now lives upon in Wake County, also one Negro man
 by the name of Arthur. Item, I give unto my dearly beloved
 daughter Betty Buckner, one Negro Girl by the name of
 Sally. Item, I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved
 daughter Betsey ^{...} on Negro slave by the name
 of Dick

I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved daughter Betty
 Womack one Negro Girl by the name of Gracy.
 Item, I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved Daughter
 Patience Thomas one Negro Girl by the name of Billy, also one
 tract of Land where she now lives upon.
 Item, I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved Daughter
 Rebecca Collins, the tract of Land where she now lives upon
 in Cumberland County, also one Negro Girl by the name of
 Nezziah, one Cow now in possession one Cow & Calves, one
 Horse and Furniture Item, I give and bequeath unto my three
 Grand Children, namely, Lucy, Henry and Minnick, some
 three Negroes namely George, Delany and Billy. Item, I give
 and bequeath unto my two Sons, Daniel and Enoch Booker
 each of the white or White Oak, the other half unto I give
 unto Barnaby Hunsar, Buck Lancia and Thomas Collins.
 I also give unto Richard, Richard, Buck Lancia, Barnaby
 Thomas, Young Lewis, Maria, Womack and Thomas Collins
 ten dollars each. Item, I leave the whole residue of my prop-
 erty not Will'd to be sold and equally divided amongst
 my children, my three Grand Children, to draw one Share
 for Lewis, I do appoint my two Enoch Booker and
 Buck Lancia to be whole and sole Executors of this my
 last Will and Testament, and James Booker do revoke
 and disannul all other Wills heretofore made by me in
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, what the day
 & date above written
 Signed sealed and delivered James ^{by} Booker
 in the presence of us
