being of sound mind and memory thanks be to God for it
calling to mind my malady and knowing that it comes
for me to die first proper to man and desire of my
willing Goods in the following that is to say in the first
place I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Obadiah
Deacon one hundred and twenty acres of Land joining
the lower end of my Land including the House, Dicks
and Spring where I now live, so as not interfere with the
Land I hereafter give to John Deacon and his wife
the said Land shall belong to my son William Deacon
Further I give and bequeath unto my son Jackson
Deacon three acres of Land including the House &
Spring above on the said Jackson Deacon now live
also twenty acres of Land in Randolph County
joining to and including the field he has cleared on
on that tract. Further I give and bequeath unto John
Deacon his improvements with the wood Land between
his fence and the oak line up the Big Branch to
the County line, thence with said line to the Land that
John Deacon bought of Edward Wilson, thence
with the Wilson line to the Branch that is at the
East end of the said John Deacon's field thence
down said Branch to the said John Deacon's fence
And order that the balance of my Land be
equally divided between my six children

Mary, Sams, Martha, Clinton, Thomas & Hance Deacon
Further I give and bequeath unto my Grandson John
Hanson one Horse Saddle and Bridle to be paid him
the said John Hanson by my sons John Jackson and
William Deacon when he arrives to the age of Twenty
or at any time when they shall think it convenient
between them and their Further I give and bequeath unto
my beloved wife one horse to ride and carriage of as she
thinks proper. Further I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Obadiah Deacon all my stock of hams Hogs and Sheep
during her life time then to be equally divided between
my six Children, Mary, Lucy, James, Martha,
Clinton and Hance Deacon.

Further order that my Rent debts be paid out of my rent
and the balance of it for the use of the family.

Further I give and bequeath my beloved wife Obadiah
Deacon all my House hold and Kitchen Furniture
and plantation Tools during her life time then to be
divided between my six Children Mary, Lucy, James,
Martha, Clinton and Hance Deacon.

Further I give I bequeath one oak Wagon to my three
sons John Jackson & William Deacon.

and I further constitute and appoint my three sons John
Jackson & William Deacon as my sole executors to the
my last will & testament after signed & acknowledged in
the presence of 13th Sept 1806. *James H. Deacon Esq.*
