Carolina, thinking it needful for the settling my  
outward affairs do make this my last will and

First I will that my executors hereinafter named

the plantation whereon I now live containing two  
hundred and ten acres which my executors will describe  
during her widow hood, also I give to my wife one

sisters that are married, I give to her all the balance of my  
household and Kitchen Furniture together with the  
farming utensils, and two cows during her life time.  
Thirdly I give to my son Edom Edwards at the decease or  
marriage of my wife Rebecca my plantation in the same man  
or less together with all the tenements and buildings according as  
my deeds describe it.

Fourthly, I give & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Edwards  
One Horse saddle and bridle, two cows, one bed and furniture  
one chest and what-

Fifthly I bequeath to my daughter Hannah One horse saddle  
and bridle, two cows, one bed and furniture one chest and  
a spinning wheel.

Sixth To my sons Joel and Edom I give ten dollars each  
in cash.

Seventh I will that my clock, Smith Took, still, and all  
other of my estate not otherwise disposed of by this my last  
will and testament be sold at my decease and all the  
monies collected and equally divided between my wife  
Rebecca and five daughters viz, Isabell  
Seminia Rachel Rebecca and Hannah

Eighth I appoint my wife Rebecca and son Edom  
to execute this my last will and testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my seal this third day of

other of my estate not otherwise disposed of by this my last  
will and testament be sold at my decease and all the  
monies collected and equally divided between my wife  
Rebecca and five daughters viz, Isabel  
Jemima, Rachel, Rebecca and Hannah

Eighth I appoint my wife Rebecca and son Edom  
to execute this my last will and Testament
