of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being
of old age and finding my bodily strength to fail daily
also remembering that it is appointed for all men once
to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
humbly revoking all other wills by me made declaring this
to be my last - first I recommend my soul to God who gave it
and my body to the dust from whence it came, and as to
what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with
I give and dispose of in the following manner - It is my
will and desire that my beloved wife have the use of the
plantation wherou I now live on the North side of Bear
Creek with all that appertains thereto, also all my Stock,
household & kitchen furniture plantation tools, during her
life; after her death the Stock Household & Kitchen furniture
and plantation tools I give and bequeath to my then daughter
namely either McDaniel, Ruth McDaniel and Sally
McDaniel - It is my will and desire that my lands be
equally divided between my children namely Belney
McDaniel, Eliza Fields, Anna McDaniel, Ruth McDaniel
Sally McDaniel, Aggy Fields, Nancy Fields, Joel McDaniel
and Richard McDaniel share and share alike so as each
McDaniel part or portion may include his dwelling and
orchard on the south side of the Creek my other children
have received what I intended for them - lastly I appoint
my two sons Joel McDaniel & Richard McDaniel my
executors - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this 2d day of April 1820
