Catherine and Ann

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Hannah
vizely two silver Dollars or the value there of in good
property Also one feather bed bedstead and furniture also

One pewter dish two pewter Plates and one skillet and
one bedding &c

Lastly I appoint my sons Adam Martin & Samuel
Martin to Execute this my last will and Testament In
Witness whereof I set my hand and seal this 10 day
of November 1800

will and bequeath to my well beloved wife Ann two cows
and one Mare two sheep one pot and back her bed and

is that my wife live on my plantation with Privilege of
said plantation and the farming thereon while she remains
my Widow I do bequeath unto my daughter Lurany Barnes

Two Shillings and Sixpence to my son John two Shillings and Sixpence
also to my Daughter Charity Piggott two Shillings and Sixpence
Like wise my son Jacob two Shillings and Sixpence and to
my Daughter Rachel two Shillings and Sixpence also one Cow
and Calf, four Shub one aid and making one Shining Wheel
also to my Son Thomas two Shillings and Sixpence also five
Tong, Pot back and hooks one pearling Calk to my Daughter
Hannah Bap Two Shillings and Sixpence also to my grandson
Joshua Murphy one cow and pearling and it is my will after
my Wifes decease or Marriage to give and bequeath to my son Jacob
one hundred Acres of Land to him and his heirs and assigns for
Ever including the Dwelling house where I now live also Calk
and bequeath to my son Thomas Ninety Eight Acres of Land
on the South Side of my Plantation and the said to be divided
by an East West Line Between them to him his heirs and assigns
for Ever, ~~the right and title of land in the same as is before~~
~~apart agreed whilst I shall live the 15th day of March 1805~~
~~and after my death and as to the same as is before~~

likewise it is my will that the remainder part of my house hold
furniture be to my Wife her life time or term of widow
hood and after her decease to be Equally divided Between my
Daughter Rachel and Son Thomas Except one Large Pewter
dish to my son Jacob Thirby dollars and disannul all other
Wills or Testaments Relaying and Confirming this and no
other to be my only Last will and Testament. Lastly
I make Ordain constitute and appoint my Beloved wife
and son Jacob to be Executors of this my Last

Will and testament to answer the intent and purpose herein
contained in certthup whereof I the said James Moon both
to this my last will and Testament Let my hand and seal
the day and year above written Signed and Sealed
