

In the Name of God Amen I James Taylor of the County
of Chatham ⁸ State of North Carolina being sick and weak
in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory
considering the uncertainty of human life and that all
men are born to die and considering the necessity of disposing
of the worldly substance wherewith it has pleased God
to bless me for the disposing of the same I do hereby make
publish and declare this to be my last will and Testa-
ment in manner and form following hereby revoking all
former Wills by me at any time heretofore made that is to say
Imprimis It is my will and desire that all my just debts
be paid and funeral expenses be first paid out of
the proceeds of the sale of my purchasable estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my son George W Taylor all the
Negroes together with their future increase and other
property of which the said George is now in possession
to him and his heirs forever —

Item I Give to my Grand Children James Womack ^{the child of my deceased daughter Mary Womack} and
Womack and Mary Womack the following Negroes
now in the possession of my son in law James Womack
viz Ben, Alfred, Alice Little, Lucia Sarah, Jac Becky,
and Linda and whereas my son in law James Womack
has sold a Negro woman named Mary with my consent
which he was to replace with another Negro of like value
now I also give the said Negro so to be replaced or in
case the said James Womack fails to replace the said
Negro then I give the proceeds of the sale of the said
Negro Mary now in the hands of the said James Womack
to my said Grand children all of the aforesaid property
to be equally divided between them share & share alike
and in case of the death of either of my said Grand
children during their Infancy then I give and bequeath
the share or shares of such grand child a child so
dying during their minority Infancy to the survivor or
survivors of my said grand children

- Item I give and devise to my son James Taylor the lands purchased
- sed by me of Philip Weston reserving however the right to any
of my family of using the Gin on the said plantation in
growing their crops of cotton - Also I give and bequeath to
my said Son James Taylor the Servt Man & two Cotts
called his
- Item I give and devise to my son Philip Taylor one hundred
7 forty acres of land including the McGee houses and
plantation beginning at my Upper Tom Dowdy line
running down the river so far as to make the said
quantity of six hundred & forty acres by running out
to my back line - I also give to my said Son Philip
Taylor a horse or horses of the value of one hundred
dollars, two cows and calves, two beds & furniture &
the stock of hogs called his
- Item I bind to my beloved wife Mary Taylor the plantation
wherein I live and all my Tracts of Land adjoining
during her Natural life and after her death I give
and devise the same to my two daughters Sarah
Taylor & Apphia Taylor to be equally divided between
them - I also bind to my said wife the value of my House-
hold furniture & Stock of every kind and herein otherwise
particularly disposed of & all my Kitchen furniture being
Wagon carts and all my plantation tools & farming
utensils -
- Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Taylor two beds
& furniture, and what Trunks and boxes are called hers
also a horse or horses of the value of one hundred dollars
two cows & calves, & the Stock of cattle called hers
- Item I give to my daughter Apphia Taylor a horse or
horses of the value of one hundred dollars two beds &
furniture two cows & calves a Bureau & what Trunks
and boxes are called hers & also the Stock of cattle
known as hers

Item It is also my desire that all my other Tracts of Land not
 given away or mentioned or intended so to be & my two
 shall be sold by my executors hereinafter named & the
 proceeds thereof to be divided equally among my said
 wife & my children James, Philip, William, Sarah &
 Apphia Taylor all the rest of my Negroes, Horses, Waggon
 Stock & Bay Lots in the Town of Pittsborough & Haywood
 & all the remainder of my estate I give to my said wife
 Mary Taylor & my four children following Reciting
 viz James, Philip, William, Sarah & Apphia Taylor
 to be equally divided between them share & share alike
 Whereas my two Daughters Sarah & Apphia having taken
 some pains with two Negro girls who have commonly waited
 on them named Celina & Rose It is my will & desire that
 in the division of my estate according to the my will that
 the said Celina & her increase be allotted to my daughter
 Sarah of the said Negro shall live & the said Rose of living
 be apportioned to my daughter Apphia together with her increase
 & that the said Negro be sold and received by my said
 Daughters in part of ~~the~~^{my} share of ~~the~~^{my} Negroes - It is also
 my desire that the ~~following~~ ^{remaining} degrees of living at the division
 of my estate viz Pegg Palmer & Cato senior be apportioned to
 my said wife and be received by her in part of her share of
 my estate I do hereby nominate my two son George W
 Taylor & James Taylor to be executors to this my last will
 & Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 10th day of May A.D 1828

Whereas my Daughter Sarah having intermarried with Mr Spencer
 M'Lean I do therefore make & do publish & declare by way
 of codicil to the within my last will & Testament this 10th day
 of November A D 1829 as follows viz all the land Negroes slave-
 holding Stock Lots in the Town of Pittsborough & Haywood
 Furniture Stock and all such part of my estate as is mentioned
 in my said will to be given to my said Daughter Sarah I do
 hereby give & devise the same to my friend Charles J Williams
 in Trust namely that he hold out the said lands I give
 out the Negroes so to be allotted him for the use & benefit of
 my said Daughter Sarah M'Lean to occupy & use the said
 land & Negroes without such Renting & Duing And in case
 of the death of my said Daughter Sarah M'Lean leaving
 any issue her surviving then that he convey the same
 to such Child or Children but in case my said Daughter
 should die without leaving such Issue then that he divide
 the same among my children George James Philip &
 Apphia Taylor Equally

 Apphia Taylor all the rest of my Negroes, Horses, Waggon
 Stock & my Lot in the Town of Pittsborough & Haywood
 & all the residue of my estate I give to my said wife
 Mary Taylor & my four children following Resely
 viz James, Philip, William, Sarah & Apphia Taylor
 to be equally divided between them share & share alike
 Whereas my two Daughters Sarah & Apphia having taken
 some pains with two Negro girls who have commonly waited
 on them named Estella & Rose It is my will & desire that
 in the division of my estate according to this my will that
 the said Estella & her increase be allotted to my daughter
 Sarah if the said Negroes shall live & the said Rose of having
 be apportioned to my daughter Apphia together with her increase
 & that the said Negroes be valued and bequeathed by my said
 Daughters in part of their share of my Negroes - It is also
 my desire that the following degrees of living at the division
 of my estate by Pegg Palmer & Cato senior be apportioned to
 my said wife and bequeathed by her in part of her share of
 my estate I do hereby nominate my two sons George W
 Taylor & James Taylor to be executors to this my last will
 & Testament & witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 11th day of May AD 1828

Whereas my Daughter Sarah having intermarried with Dr Spencer
 M'Leanahan I do therefore make Ordan publish & declare by way
 of codicil to the within my last will & Testament this 12th day
 of November A D 1829 as follows viz all the land Negroes slave
 iration Stock lots in the Towns of Pittsborough & Haywood
 Furniture Stock and all such part of my estate as is mentioned
 in my said will to be given to my said Daughter Sarah I do
 hereby give & devise the same to my friend Charles J Williams
 in Trust nevertheless that he hold out the said lands & hire
 out the Negroes so to be allotted him for the use & benefit of
 my said Daughter Sarah M'Leanahan to occupy & use the said
 land & Negroes without such Letting & Hiring And in case
 of the death of my said Daughter Sarah M'Leanahan
 leaving any issue her surviving her that he convey the same
 to such Child or Children but in case my said daughter
 should die without leaving such Issue then that he convey
 the same among my children George James Philip &
 Apphia Taylor Equally
