 mind and memory do make the following to be my last will
 and testament that is first I resign my soul to god
 who gave it and my body to be decently buried entered in
 Christian Burial And as to my worldly estate I dispose of in
 the following Manner to wit I give unto my Daughter Agnella
 that a Negro girl named Linda to her and her heirs forever
 I give unto my son Hope Buckner a Negro man named Peter
 to him and his heirs forever I give unto my Daughter Sarah
 Jane a Negro Girl named Popsy to be her property her life
 time then to be equally divided between her daughters Polly
 Rachel and Fanny Johnson to them and their heirs forever
 I give unto my daughter Peggy ~~Shaw~~ ^{Shaw} Sixty dollars
 to be paid out of my estate by my executor I give unto my
 grand daughter Susannah Buckner One hundred dollars to be
 paid as above named I also give Ten dollars to be equally
 divided between the heirs of my son Nathaniel Buckner &
 Susannah excepted as to her part of the Ten dollars I also
 give unto my son Martha Johnson One shilling to gether
 with the contents attached to it I also give unto Nancy Hogan
 One hundred dollars to be paid out of my estate by my
 executor I also give unto my son John Buckner a certain
 tract of land whereon he now lives together with a Mother
 small tract adjoining the same containing one hundred
 and eighty acres in all to him and his heirs forever
 I also give unto Martha Buckner son of Hope Buckner
 and Buckner Johnson son of Hope Johnson my tract
 of land whereon I now live to be equally divided between
 them at my death I also give unto Nancy Hogan

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 One Chest One Walnut & one pine Chest which is now in
 my house I also give unto the heirs of my son Eliza
 Buckner five dollars to be equally divided between
 them to be paid out of my estate I also give unto my
 son William Buckner five dollars to be paid as above
 I also give unto Rich Buckner my son five dollars
 to be paid as above named I also give unto my son Ed-
 ward Buckner five dollars to be paid as above named
 I also give unto the heirs of my daughter Polly that
 she five dollars to be equally divided between them to be
 paid out of my estate as above I also give unto my grand
 son Samuel Jones sixty dollars to be paid out of my estate
 the balance of my estate after paying all my just debts to
 be divided in the following manner viz to my daughter Peggy
 that Sixty dollars to her and her heirs and also to my daughter
 Agnella that I give sixty dollars to her and her heirs in addition
 to what was before mentioned I also give to my son Rich-
 ard Buckner sixty dollars in addition to what was before given
 the balance of my estate if any to be equally divided between
 my three youngest children viz John Buckner Ed. Buckner
 and Martha Johnson and I do Ordain and Appoint Hope Buckner
 and Jeph. Shaw my whole and sole executor the writing
 whereof I have set my hand and seal the twenty sixth
 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty six
 Signed and sealed in the presence of Witnesses
 Hope Buckner
