being in a low state of health but perfect in mind and have  
every thing for I make this my last will and testament  
the matter and form as follows. first I recommend my  
soul to God that guard it and my Body to the Earth to be  
buried in a Christian like manner. and touching such  
worldly goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with  
in this life I give and despoil of the same in the fol-  
lowing manner viz. Item 1. I give and bequeath to my  
Daughter Sally Cox one negro girl named Penny and one  
negro boy named Harry - Item 2. I give and bequeath to my  
Daughter Polly Cox what money she has received from a  
negro man named Brad - Item 3. I give and bequeath to  
my Daughter Elizabeth Albritton a negro girl named  
Hilli and one man and all my Stock of Cattle except the  
choice Cow & Calf - Item 4. I give and bequeath to my  
son William Scott one negro man named Pompey and  
negro woman named Sal and one Cott and all my Stock  
of Hogs. Item 5. I give and bequeath to my Daughter  
Nancy Plains one negro man named David. Item 6. I  
give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebekah Thomas  
one negro girl named Millie and one negro boy named  
Sam and one Cow and Calf the choice of all I have  
Item 7. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Polly  
Partridge one negro girl named Rachib and one negro  
boy named Lemphrey - Also give and bequeath to my  
Daughter Sally Cox and Rebekah Thomas two negro children  
name Isaac and Runah to be valued and equally di-  
vided between the two and for the same Sally Cox must  
pay Polly Cox my Daughter one hundred Dollars and  
Rebekah must pay to Nancy Plains one hundred Dollars

I also give to my Negro Sal my Bed and furniture - 49  
The balance of my property to be sold and equally  
divided among all my Children - I also appoint William  
Gowt and Doctor Thomas Cottrell Executors to this my  
last Will and Testament - I do hereby revoke all other  
Wills by me made and acknowledge this to be my last  
Will and Testament in presence of us -

W Thomas West of the County of Chatham Farmer do  
humbly make my last Will and Testament revoking all  
other hereofor made - In the first place I appoint my  
son my second Son and Joseph MacEacham my Son in law  
from the reliance I have in their integrity my Executors  
to execute and carry into effect this my Will - Secondly  
I have and bequeath to my said Executors Joseph and  
Joseph all my Estate real and personal for whom, hitherto  
the trust now declared in this my Will (it being my prin-  
cipal Object and desire to provide for my wife) should  
she outlive me during her life comfortably and that  
at her death all my estate should be equally divided  
amongst my twelve Children or the representatives of such  
as may be deceased at my death - Therefor appoint my  
said Executors Trustees to divide my estate as follows  
to wit that my whole Estate shall be appropriated here  
to afford a comfortable support to my wife during her  
life and at her death either by sale division in lots or
