North Carolina do hereby make my last Will and Testament
and declare it to be the following. I will and bequeath to my
two Sons John & Alexander McLean the tract of land on which
I now live of three hundred acres. & also one hundred acres
of land joining a tract of land belonging to little John McLean

and farming utensils, Cows hogs Hens & Sheep as also
a Negro Wench named Margaret and a Negro boy named
Amelia - my above named two sons John & Edward
Wilson am to pay any debts I may happen to owe at
the time of my death as also pay to Duncan Wilson my
son as his share of my property real or personal Sixty
Dollars in Six Months after my decease - My above named
two sons John & Edward shall also pay to my son
Kenneth Wilson fifty Dollars as his share of my property
real or personal in Nine Months after my decease - my said
two sons John & Edward shall have to pay to my daughter
Mary Nicolson twenty Dollars as her share of my property
real or personal, as also twenty Dollars to my Daughter
Catharine Wilson as her share of my property real or personal
I will and bequeath to my son Duncan Wilson the sum
of Sixty Dollars for his share of my property to be paid as
above by my foreaid two sons John & Edward Wilson -
I will and bequeath to my son Kenneth Wilson fifty Dollars
to be paid as above by the foreaid two sons John & Edward
in full of his share of my property real or personal - I will
and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Nicolson twenty Dollars
as her share of my property real or personal to be paid as
above by my said two sons John & Edward - I will and
bequeath to my Daughter Catharine Wilson twenty Dollars
as her share of my property real or personal to be paid as
above by my foreaid two sons John & Edward - And lastly I will
and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Wilson a Negro girl
named Amelia as her share of my property real or personal - And
I hereby declare this to be my last will & Testament - In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of April 1815
