and Arthur also two better beds and garnitures -

I Item the third I bind my land and plantations
with all my plantation tools to my beloved sister
Elizabeth Barkam during her natural life and
after her death I Give it to William Barkam -

I Item the fourth I wish all my Stock of Horses
Cattle Hogs and Sheep to be equally divided be-
tween my sister Elizabeth Barkam and William

Barkam and all the remainder of my estate of
every description that remains and not otherwise disposed
of I Give to my beloved Cousin William Barkam
And I hereby revoke all former wills and clauses of
wills by me at any time heretofore made and I
hereby nominate and appoint William Barkam
sole executor to this my last will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 28th day of February in the Year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one
