I will my house hold and furniture passing her
the rest of her life and then the whole to be sold and
equally divided between all my heirs.

I Give unto my Grand daughter Mary Row and
Cass Thomas by the name of White face & living joint
heirs to be paid out of the sale of my estate to her
and her heirs for ever. Then the remaining part of
my Estate to be sold and after paying all my debts with
the residue to be equally divided between all my heirs.
And I do nominate and appoint my wife Mary
Row & Solomon Row my Executors & Executors
of this my last Will & Testament making all other
Wills by me made void and declaring this to be my
last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th Sept. in
the year of our Lord 1799.
