 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, that
 is to say. Principally and first of all I give and recommend
 my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and
 my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent
 Christian burial. And as touching such worldly estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this
 life, I give, devise, dispose of the same in the following
 manner and form. First I give I bequeath unto my
 beloved Wife Margaret, one Horse Creature Two Cows,
 her choice of my Stock, both Hens & Cows, two Hens,
 two Quainties, six fater plums, six Spears, Two Dishes, Two
 Basons, one Table, Two Chairs, one Stool, Three Nails
 & Three Forks, one Saddle, one Whisk, one Pot & Dutch
 Oven, one Coffee Mill, one Coffee Pot & Two Stairs
 also the my beloved Wife to have full possession of my
 plantation and Land including the House & buildings on
 said premises, the Store including coming for life time
 2^d And unto my daughter Elizabeth I give I bequeath
 Fifty Dollars First and foremost to be paid out of
 my estate to her & her heirs, and afterwards to have an

247 equal part with the rest of my Heirs, all the remainder
of movable property, not Money to be sold at public sale
and the money to be equally divided among all my Children
except my son Adam, whom I have given him one Heir-
one Twenty Dollars in Cash that be his part and no more
but I will that his two youngest sons viz Paul and Thomas
sons of the said Adam have an equal part with all the
rest of my Heirs viz. The two, viz after the come of age
and to the age of Twenty one years that be do remember
the Money they have already received of me to be included
in their part. I will that my son Jacob Smith have my
Land and premises which I now live after my, and
my Wife's death to him and his heirs forever, he pay
Five Hundred Dollars to his Brothers and Sisters viz
Fifty Dollars to each or either, there being more than one
to be received out of the above sum. The said Jacob
pay in Fifty Dollars to his oldest Sister two years after
my death, then Fifty Dollars to the next oldest the
year following, and so on until he has paid the Four
Hundred Fifty Dollars. Jacob & Thomas not to be paid
until the come of age. And I truly appoint and constitute
my beloved Friends Isaac Bolton and Benjamin
Hild execution of this my last Will and Testament, and
do hereby ^{authorize} allow, revoke, & annul all and every
Will & Testament, Testimony & confirming this and
no other to be my last Will & Testament. In
