(except my son John White) and after the death of my wife he is to have
the whole of my Estate real and personal. I do hereby constitute and
appoint my wife and my son John White Executors of this my last
Will and Testament. In witness I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal this 14th July 1799

mind and memory do hereby declare this 29th day of September in the
year of our Lord Christ 1798 make and publish this my last Will
and Testament in manner following. I give unto my son John
to him his heirs and assigns forever five shilling Sterling. I also give
unto my son Richard Lewis & Lewis the sum of ^{five} shilling of each
to them and their heirs forever. I give unto my wife one hundred
and fourteen pounds in coin and wood what she put on her
and calf and one mare to her and her heirs forever. I also give
unto my son David one mare that he has in possession and one cow
and calf to him and his heirs forever. I also give to my Daughter
Mary Ann one bed and what to her and her heirs forever. I give unto
my son Theophilus one Riff Gun one young mare and one heifer
speaking to him and his heirs forever.
