at our death an equal division be made of my lands
among all my Children, male and female, and after
providing my Son Hugh Peoples with an acre or more, that
is choice of Farm, a horse, or horse, a good horse, two
cows, and calves, and one bed and furniture, an equal
division be made of the balance of my property among
all my Children, share and share alike -

The property named above to my Son Hugh Peoples
in order to make him equal with those that have
left me and me? such a portion. My desire is when
my lands is divided that my Son Hugh may be
intitled to that lot or portion which including
the dwelling house, and adjoining buildings.
My will and desire is that my Children male
and female be equally intitled in all my real
estate. Lastly I hereby appoint Cornelius Womble
my Son in Law, Brooks Harris, Thomas Rivers
my sons in Law, and my son Hugh Peoples my
executors to this my last will and testament. Witness
