the whole of my Estate real and personal. I do hereby constitute and
appoint my wife and my son John White Executors of this my last

year of our Lord Christ 1798 make and publish this my last Will
and Testament in manner following. I give unto my son John
to him his heirs and assigns forever five shillings Sterling. I also give
unto my son Richard Lewis & Lewis the sum of ^{five} shillings of each
to them and their heirs forever. I give unto my wife one feather
bed and furniture on him and what she will. I also give
and sell and convey unto her and her heirs forever I also give
unto my son David on man that he be in possession and the cow
and calf to him and his heirs forever. I also give to my daughter
Mary on land and what to her and her heirs forever. I give unto
my son Theophilus on Riffe Gun on young mare and on horse
(yearling) to him and his heirs forever.
