

State of North Carolina Nov. 10<sup>th</sup>. A.D. One thousand  
Eight hundred and eight  
(1848)

Known all men by these presents that Joshua Williams being  
of sound mind blessed be God for it knowing the un-  
certainty of this life & the certainty of death do now  
make and ordain this my last will & Testament in the  
form following To wit

Item 1<sup>st</sup> My will is that all my just debts shall be paid  
(paying 4 dollars for my funeral expenses) -

Item 2.<sup>nd</sup> I leave unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Williams all of  
my land where I now live with all its appurtenances during  
her natural life I also give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth  
Williams One third part of my negroes to have & to hold  
to act and dispose of them as she may think proper - Also  
I give unto my beloved wife One third part of all my personal  
property to act and dispose of as she may think proper

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah  
Ann C. Williams all the residue of property both real  
and personal (not given to my wife) to have & to hold to her  
and her heirs forever - And if my said daughter  
should die leaving no legal heir of her own body then  
in that case my will is that her estate both real & personal  
shall be divided into four parts One fourth part to my beloved  
sister Elizabeth Harkay & her heirs forever One fourth part  
to my beloved brother Anderson Williams and his heirs  
forever One fourth part to any other lawful heirs, One fourth  
part to Foreign Missions to be paid over to the Treasurer  
of that board to be appropriated to that purpose -  
If there should be any property either real or personal  
not given away herebefore in this will it is then to be  
equally divided between all my legal heirs -

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I hereby nominate and appoint Joshua W.  
Harkay Guardian for my beloved daughter Sarah A. Williams

Item 5. I hereby nominate and appoint William Griffin  
& Turner Byrum my executors to this my last will  
& Testament In the presence of G. Ward & his son  
at my hand and affixed my seal the day & date above written  
Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of John A. Harkay  
Anderson Kirby Joshua Williams (Seal)

This certifies that the foregoing last will & Testament of  
Joshua Williams died ~~in a~~ <sup>recently</sup> in open Court

In the name of God amen - I Elijah Bell of the County  
of Chatham & State of North Carolina being in a low state of  
health but of sound mind & memory as usual shall be  
to God for it do make and ordain this paper writing  
to be my last will & Testament in manner following -

Fir<sup>t</sup> that all my just debts be paid

2d. I give and bequeath unto my cousin Bennett Lazarus  
a certain negro boy by the name Amor, to him & his heirs  
in fee simple forever -

3d. Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Jonathan Clark  
a certain negro girl by the name of Lucy to him & his heirs  
in fee simple forever -

4th Item - I give & bequeath to my sister Sarah Clark  
during her natural life a certain negro girl by the name of  
Louisa and after the death of my sister as aforesaid I dis-  
pose and request that said negro girl Louisa be left free -

5th Item - I give & bequeath to my nephew Joseph Bell  
son of Thomas Bell Five certain negro boys namely Sidney  
Hastly Green Elijah Gilbert to him & his heirs in fee simple  
forever -

6th Item - I give and bequeath to my old friend John Clark  
One Hundred dollars to him & his heirs forever -

7. Item - I give & bequeath to my nephew Elijah Clark  
a certain negro girl by the name Eliza & her child Jasmin  
et to him & his heirs in fee simple forever -

8th Item I give & bequeath to my brother Thomas Bell  
& Sister Susannah Clark all my lands to be equally divided  
between them to them & their heirs in fee simple forever -

9th Item I give & bequeath to my brother Thomas Bell  
all the residue of my property both real & personal that  
I have not heretofore given away to him & his heirs in  
fee simple forever -

10th Item - And lastly I do here nominate constitute  
and appoint my Brother Thomas Bell my Executor
