I leave to my Wife during life or widowhood the Land and plantation whereon I now live and also the Pogram tract for two and two children use, also one Awar and Cott with all the household Furniture plantation Tools and utensils &c. also the balance of my stock Hogs I leave to my Wife in manner before mentioned with my present standing crop for the use of her & my children. And I hereby make & declare my writing to be my last Will & Testament of this my last Will & Testament.
