It is also my will that my son John Moran have one cow & calf my wagon & gear one bed & furniture six gear —

It is also my will that my daughter Nancy have one bed and furniture six gear and twenty dollars to be paid to her out of the sale of my property that shall be exposed to sale —

It is also my will that my grand son McCajah Thomas have two Cows & one cow —

It is also my will that the Residue of my property of all descriptions be sold and the Money equally divided between my five daughters and in case of the death of either of them their heirs big Minny Martin bloy Real Nancy Moran Mary Thomas and Patience Howard and in case of the death of either of my daughters Patience

Howard or Mary Thomas the property going to either shall equally be inherited by their children — I leave my son William & John Moran executors to this my last will and Testament

In the Name of God Amen the 14th day of July 1830 I Sarah Kemp of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say my will is that my Just debts and funeral charges be paid. I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah my two horses two cows and calves and all my stock of Hogs and sheep and all my farming tools household and kitchen furniture except one set of tea cups and saucers and one bottle which I give unto her while she remains my widow and I give and bequeath unto my wife Sarah one bed and furniture one loom and one side saddle and one Cotton wheel during her life time — I also will and bequeath unto my son Joseph one Rifle gun and ^{my} Bull Calf which I will and bequeath unto him his heirs and assigns forever I likewise will and bequeath unto my daughter Ruth one sheep half and one white bottle I will unto her her heirs and assigns forever

I also will and bequeath unto my daughter Wilmet one set of tea cups and saucers

And it also is my will that my two woodwork of ~~wings~~ ^{my} be sold and the Money equally divided amongst all my children — And I hereby Make and ordain my wife Sarah and my brother Josiah Kemp executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the ~~said~~ Josiah Kemp have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this day and year above written — Signed sealed published and declared by the ~~said~~ Josiah Kemp the Testator as his last will and Testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof
