one the third part of my wearing apparel.
4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor Thirty
dollars & three pence of my wearing apparel & to give and
bequeath unto my Four Grand Daughters namely Eleanor
Pain, Katherine and Mary Coddle daughters of my
daughter Deborah Thirty Dollars equally divided amongst them
etc. I bequeath to my grand Daughter Pain library one
third part of my wearing apparel. It is my Will and
desire that the residue of my estate after the above bequeath
ments are paid or removed out of my effects as hereafter
directed be equally divided between my son Simon my
daughter Eleanor and my Four Grand Daughters above
named that is, one thira part to my son Simon. The other
part to my daughter Eleanor & one one thira part to my
Four Grand Daughters. If my legates can amongst them
divide my effects to the satisfaction of each legate as above
directed if not all and divide the amount as to each
one direct, except my wearing apparel let them be paid
by my sister Deborah Nolin and applicat to the use
of them direct to. Lastly I constitute and appoint
my son Simon whole and sole Executor of this my
last Will and Testament and hereby revoke all others

to this my last Will & Testamente set my Hand & Seal the
