 of life and the necessity of settling and adjusting all
 worldly concerns in a manner agreeable to myself

 interred: then my effects with pounds in money which I should
 to have will be found in my son Simon's hands. 2nd That all
 my Just debts be paid by my executor as soon after my
 decease as the situation of my estate will admit.
 3rd I give and bequeath unto daughter Deborah five shillings
 and the third part of my wearing apparel.
 4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor thirty
 dollars a third part of my wearing apparel & I give and
 bequeath unto my four grand daughters; namely Eleanor
 Fair, Katharine and Mary Elliott daughters of my dear
 John Deborah thirty Dollars equally divide amongst them
 5th I bequeath to my grand daughter Jane & Mary one
 third part of my wearing apparel 7th It is my Will and
 desire that the residue of my estate after the above legacies
 are paid or received out of my effects as hereafter
 directed be equally divided between my son Simon my
 daughter Eleanor and my four grand daughters above
 named that is, one third part to my son Simon. One third
 part to my daughter Eleanor & one one third part to my
 four grand daughters. If my legacies can amongst them
 divide my effects to the satisfaction of each legatee is above
 divided with if not all and divide the amount as to each
 one divides except my wearing apparel let them be divided
 by my sister Deborah Melvin and applied to the use
 of them divided to. lastly I constitute and appoint
 my son Simon whole and sole Executor of this my
 last Will and Testament and do hereby revoke all other

tation Tools and utensils &c. also the balance of my
stock Hogs I leave to my Wife in manner before men-
tioned with my present standing crop for the use of her
& my children. And I hereby make & declare my writing
to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I the said Joseph Seale have
to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the
