I am my Will is that all the rest of my estate which consist
of house hold and furniture be sold and my daughter Mary

sale to go, the One half of it to the Children of my daughter
Susanah Burl and the other half to the Children of my
daughter Anna Almonston and lastly I make and appoint
my son John Cook my sole Executor to this last Will and

I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day
