Dixon to be his last will and testament

Proved February 23rd 1824

Be it known that I Mary McLean of Chatham County  
State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body but perfect  
in mind and memory, knowing the uncertainty of time do make  
and give this my last Will and Testament in Manner and substance  
First I order that all my Just debts, together with my funeral  
Charges be paid. I give and bequeath unto my dear daughter  
my Bed and furniture left to me by my Grandfather Woody  
I give and bequeath the Remainder of my Household furniture  
and wearing apparel to be equally divided among my daughters  
namely Rachel Woody, Eleanor Woody, Hannah Woody, Mary Woody
