J. Coxson Esquire Son of Chatham County and State
of North Carolina being very low and weak of body
but in perfect mind and memory and desiring to make
his last wishes for all to be done I therefore commit
my Soul to him that made it and my body to the
earth to be buried at the discretion of my executors and
as touching my worldly Goods I will and bequeath
them as follows. I will to my son Robert Esquire
all my Lands whereon I now live to him his Heirs &
but he is to pay my debts. Also that my beloved
Wife is to have her life time in it in Peace and
quietness; And my son George is to have the piece of
ground called his to live as long as his Mother doth
live; And as to my moveable property I will that
it be equally divided between my three Sons, Henry
George and Richard: And will to my son John
and Abathus to each Five Shillings and to my son
William's five Shillings each lawful money this
to be divided after the death of my Wife at ten, but
for her to keep all in her possession as long as she live

I also appoint my son Robert and Brother Francis
Esquires Executors to this my last Will and Testament
At witness my Hand and Seal this 2nd Day of June 1800

if she remains a Widow without any restriction to sell
Lands; likewise my Household Furniture I leave and bequeath
to my Lucy the use of it her life time without a binding
it or making away with it. William Henry I leave give
one cow at Lucy's decease Lucy is to have the use of
Stock of Cattle Hogs and Horses for life time or inalienable
at the old woman's death or marriage. And Daniel
Brown to have a Cow at the old woman's death or
marriage. And Negro slave Peter may live with which
of the Children he please his life time after my decease
And at Lucy's death or marriage all my personal
