had lived the same I will and bequeath to my grandson
Michael son of Edward. Lastly I make and ordain and
appoint my son Thomas ^{my} Son in law Thomas Buckner executor
of this my last Will in testimony to answer the intent
and purpose therein contained Witness my hand of the said
Michael Johnson Sur. have to this my last Will and Testament
