and memory, and calling to mind the mortality of my
body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die
I do make this my last Will and Testament. First of all I
recommend my soul to a heavenly God that gave it to me
to have a decent Burial. My Will is that my son Josiah
Harris shall have a little Negro Girl called Phoebe
that my Father Will a me in his last Will. My Will further
is that my son Josiah have the Horse that my Father left
me in his last Will. also one Bed and Furniture one Cow &
Calf that was left me in my Father's last Will. My
Will further is that my son Josiah Harris have the prop-
erty that belongs to me in the Western Country after paying
the charges for going after the said property. Also my
Will further is that William Snipes be appointed Guardian

for my son Josiah Hamar and that he may go
 to his Country and bring the property belonging
 and a son Josie to the Country to support my
 only for said strips to be paid out of my property
 going after the above mentioned property. also of the
 further is that my son Josie Hamar have my
 permission that I am now in possession of. My Will
 is that in case my son Josie Hamar shall not
 be alive to the age of Twenty one years. that in that
 my Will is that all my surviving Brothers and Sisters
 shall equally divide the property belonging or
 belong to my son Josie Hamar. And lastly I do
 and appoint my beloved Friend Melvins Strips
 lawful executor and receiving all due by me
 as made and drawn this to be my last Will and
 Testament. In witness whereof I the said Melvins
 have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 6th
 August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 and Nineteen

 my Just debts be paid by my executor as soon after my
 decease as the situation of my estate will admit
 3rd I give and bequeath unto daughter Deborah five shillings
 and the third part of my wearing apparel
 4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor thirty
 dollars a third part of my wearing apparel & I give and
 bequeath unto my four grand daughters; namely Eleanor
 Fair, Katharine and Mary Elliott daughters of my dear
 John Deborah thirty Dollars equally divide amongst them
 5th I bequeath to my grand daughter Jane & Mary one
 third part of my wearing apparel 7th It is my Will and
 desire that the residue of my estate after the above legacies
 are paid or received out of my effects as hereafter
 directed be equally divide between my son Simon my
 daughter Eleanor and my four grand daughters above
 named that is, one third part to my son Simon. One third
 part to my daughter Eleanor & one one third part to my
 four grand daughters. If my legacies can amongst them
 divide my effects to the satisfaction of each legatee is above
 divide with if not all and divide the amount as to each
 one divides except my wearing apparel let them be divided
 by my sister Deborah Melvin and applica to the use
 of them divide to. lastly I constitute and appoint
 my son Simon whole and sole Executor of this my
 last Will and Testament and do hereby revoke all other
