 the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina in con-
 sideration of the sum of two hundred pounds Current money of the
 State aforesaid to me in hand paid by William Morgan of the
 County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknow-
 ledge have bargained, sold, released, granted and confirmed
 unto the said William Morgan a certain Negro boy by the
 name of Jack about fourteen years old to him and to hold the
 said Negro Jack and all and singular the property in said Negro
 unto the said William Morgan and that the said Parsh
 Self for himself, his Heirs, Executors and assigns with agreement
 the said William Morgan to warrant said Negro boy and his
 heirs from all other person or persons whatsoever all the right
 title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of in or to the said
 Negro and that the said William Morgan is now at this
 time placed in quiet and peaceable possession of said Negro
 Which the said Parsh Self with lawful and proper influence
 Given under his hand and seal the 31st day of Dec^r 1799
