and declare this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
all former Wills by me made, and first and principally I
give my soul to almighty God, and body to the earth to be
buried in a Christian and decent manner by my executors
hereafter named, and as for my worldly estate I give the
same as follows. First it is my Will that Davidson shall
have all my personal property, I am. I give the land I
now live on to my daughter Annanah Davidson & after her
death to her Children; and I do hereby nominate & appoint

Davidson my sole & sole Executors of this my last Will and
