for pardon of all my Sins and salvation through Merits & Pleasings
of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ Amen My body I bequeath
to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such like
manner as my friends shall see me need put away & as to my
worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me withal
I give and dispose of as follows Viz I promise I give & bequeath
to my wife Polly Boon all my land and Movable Estate during her
life after all my Just debts are paid and the Executors has in their
power to sell such part of my Movable Estate as they may think
proper to discharge my debts, and after her death as which all
my Estate to be sold, and giving such Credit as the Executors may
think proper and to be equal divided between all my Children as long
as they live and then to be divided between my Grand Children

I wish ^{done} my Daughter Pamelina daughter Mary Ann Boon not the
cut of equal share of her Mother's share also my daughter Amey
Ann Wrasley Boon not to be cut out of equal part of her Mother's
part of my estate - Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my
dear wife Polly Boon and Stephen Petty to be my true and lawful
Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of August 1837
