And declare this to be my last will and Testament in
Manner and form following hereby revoking all former
wills h^t have made heretofore at any time made unto me Made
viz - In witness It is my desire that out of the proceeds
of my the sale of my payable Estate herein after
directed to be sold that all my just debts & funeral expen-
ses be paid Item I give and devise unto my beloved
wife Ann Cotten the plantation whereon I now live Also
my round Top tract of land adjoining the lands of
Wmshf. Stearns & others Also my tract of land lying
near Rocky River adjoining the lands of Thomas Ellegd
& others Also my lot in the Town of Haywood Now
land 117. And a moiety of a lot in said Town now
land - Also I give and bequeath unto my
said wife the following Negroes to wit - Tom Harry Harry
Minor Weston old Charles & Betty their Child Nancy Anne Cyrus
Nelson Eliza David Jackson. Cinderella. And her three Children
Nana Mary & John Mary Ann And her two Children Alfred Piggy
& Lewis together with the future increase of the female family
Also all my Crock and Stock of every kind description
On the plantation whereon I have now reside & all my
household And kitchen furniture of plantation tools

gaining Marcus May Gig and Coopers with the exception of my
Plaza good house which I give and bequeath unto my Son
Richard C. Cotton also I give unto my said wife forty Bushels
of corn out of the crop raised on my New plantation.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Stephen Wright Cotton
my plantation on Haw River Adjoining the lands of Woodson Lee
and others also I give and bequeath unto my said Son Stephen
Wright the following Negroes to wit Edmund Lester & his
the Children Hester & Anne & Ordina Sime & Marcell together
with the future increase of the female ~~family~~ slaves -

It is my will & desire that out of the proceeds of the sale of my
jewelry estate not herein otherwise disposed of that my Counter
part after named buy for my said wife the Negro girl formerly
owned by the named Harrod

It is also my will that the residue of my estate be divided
into two lots one of which I give unto the children of my Son
Richard C. Cotton to be equally divided between them Share
and Share alike the other lot I leave unto my said Son
Stephen Wright C. Cotton during his natural life at his
death I give unto the said children of my said Son Richard
C. Cotton provided nevertheless that if my said Son Stephen Wright
shall shall leave alive at his death any child or children of his
body lawfully begotten then I give the last mentioned lot unto such
child or children. I do hereby nominate & appoint my said wife & my
Friend Thomas Snipes Esq to be my Executor to this my last will &
Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
16th day of May A.D. 1824.
