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Our negro woman named Fanny to dispose of them as she may prefer.

5. I give & bequeath unto my son John F. Burnett the land and plantation wherein he now lives containing three hundred & fifty seven acres lying on Potte Barry Creek, I give & bequeath unto him one negro man named Jordan one ditto named Daniel one negro woman named Martha with her present & future increase. 6. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Snipes one negro man named Jack one negro woman named Rosa with her present & future increase. 7. I give & bequeath unto my son Lucian Burnett the tract of land wherein I now live but he is not to take possession of that part left to his Mother until after her death or marriage also one other tract known by the name of the Bush Mountain tract I also give him one negro man named Fielden one ditto named Solomon one negro woman named Wafay with her present & future increase.

8. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Julia F. Baldwin one negro man named Bryant one negro woman named Mary with her present & future increase.

8. My will further is that all of the negroes that are or already will be away my daughter Nancy Snipes is to have as many as will amount to fifteen hundred dollars.

9. My will further is that my daughter Julia F. Baldwin receive the same sum in the valuation of negroes as her sister Nancy Snipes is to receive the balance of the negroes after a clothing to Nancy Snipes her fifteen hundred dollars worth & Julia F. Baldwin her fifteen hundred worth and to be equally divided between my son John F. Burnett Nancy Snipes Lucian Burnett & Julia F. Baldwin.

My will further is at the death or marriage of this (Mother) that all the property that I have owned he be equally divided between John F. Burnett Nancy Snipes Lucian Burnett & Julia F. Baldwin.

My will further is that one thousand dollars be put out on interest my son Executor and the interest collected yearly & paid over to my daughter Eliza M. Keckover for her support & my will further is that after my death that all my short crop all the balance of my estate but it consist of what it may be that has not already been will be away be sold first a credit of nine months then to be collected & the debts that are due of the debts the balance after taking out the thousands Mr. Keckover is to be equally divided between John F. Burnett Nancy Snipes Lucian Burnett & Julia F. Baldwin.

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My will further is that if John F. Burnett Nancy Snipes Lucian Burnett Julia F. Baldwin either of them be dead at my death then the part given to him her or them that are dead at my death is to be equally divided between their lawful issue. I hereby make & ordain John F. Burnett Edwin P. Snipes Lucian Burnett & Joseph J. Baldwin Executors of this my last will & Testament reserving all former wills by me made. In testimony whereof I the said Isaac Burnett hath hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written signed sealed published & declared by the said Isaac Burnett the Testator at his last will & Testament in the presence of us who are present at the time of signed & sealing the same.
