 State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the bargain and
 affection which I have and as now have a my living daughter
 Mary Kirby and her husband Wright Kirby of the County and
 State aforesaid have given and granted and by these presents do
 give and grant unto the said Wright Kirby and Mary Kirby his
 wife and negro girl named Betty about fourteen years of age and
 one negro boy named Francis about six years of age being the
 same two negroes that I gave to my daughter Mary in the partition of
 Gideon Goodwin and Sarah Goodwin about two years since to the
 said Wright Kirby and to hold the above named negroes and the said
 Gideon Goodwin Junior by these presents without any manner of
 coercion give the above mentioned negroes unto the said Wright
 Kirby and Mary Kirby his wife their heirs Executors
 partners In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this 25th day of May Anno Domini 1798
