Following To wit First of all I bequeath unto my
wife Elizabeth my plantation whereon I ~~now~~
live also my ^{upper} plantations ~~whereon~~ on Stinking
Creek also all my slaves also all my stock
of every kind and all my household and
kitchen furniture and crop of every kind
and at the death of my wife I give unto my
son Feril Gunter the plantation on haw River
whereon I ~~now~~ live also I give to my said son
Feril at the death of his said Mother Two Negro
Boys by the names of Oliver & Peter and one
fourth part of all the Remainder of my estate
and that the said Feril Gunter pay to my
four Grand Children David Bennet. Elizabeth
Elijah & Charity Holomons two hundred dollars
and in the the third place at the death of my said
wife I Give to my son John Gunter as follows
(To wit) My upper plantation on Stinking Creek
and also my two boys by the names of Nelson
& Isaac and one fourth part of all the
Remainder of my Estate and that the said
John Gunter pay to my three Grand Children
(To wit) William. Richard and Saml Gunter
two hundred dollars and it is also further my
will that my four Grand Children (To wit)
Bennet. Elizabeth. Elijah & Charity Holomons
have one fourth part of all my Estate not

previously given away and should one or more die
without issue that their share ~~be~~ ^{be} ~~entitled~~ ^{entitled} ~~to~~ ^{to}
descend to their surviving Brothers and Sisters, and
it is further My Will that my three Grand Sons
(Sons) William, Richard & James Gunter, have one
fourth part of all my Estate not previously given
away and should one or more die without
issue that such deceased part to descend to the
Survivors, And I do also Constitute appoint and
ordain Thomas Parator & Abner Gunter Sen:
Executors to this my last will and Testament
Published and pronounced in
the presence of us Witnesses
