to be his absolutely at my death and one  
half of the balance of my negros which I have  
not given to James & Hugh and also one  
feather Bed at the death of his mother

Item it is my desire that if any of my negros  
should have children after the execution of this  
will that the increase shall go with the  
mother

Item I authorise my Executor to sell as much  
of my crop stock or provisions which I have  
given to my wife as may be sufficient to pay  
my just debts and funeral expences

I appoint my son Hugh Executor to this  
my last will & Testament signed sealed  
published and declared on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April  
A.D. 1840

First I command my soul to God who gave it & my

Item I give & devise to my wife Nancy one third of the  
tract of land on which I now live including the  
dwelling house & all the out houses, to have & to hold  
to her for and during her natural life & at her death  
I give & devise the same to my son Robert W. Palmer &  
his heirs forever I also give to my said wife the following  
negros (viz) Betty Redick & John & the increase they  
may hereafter have to have & to hold to her & her heirs  
absolutely Item I ratify & confirm the gift which

I have heretofore made by deed to my son John Jos-  
eph Palmer of the tract of land which I purchased  
of Philip Alston I also give & bequeath to my son  
John Joseph all the negros which I have heretofore  
put into his possession & the increase that they have  
had since they have been in his possession as well as

that they may hereafter have to have & to hold to him  
& his heirs forever Item I give & devise to my son  
John Joseph Palmer & to his executors & administrators  
the tract of land that I purchased of Philip White  
also all the negros that I have heretofore put into the  
possession of my son Lemuel W. Palmer & the increase

of said negroes since they have been in my son  
J. M. Palmers Possession & the increase that they may  
have hereafter & in addition to them a negro boy by the  
name of Sare upon this special trust & confidence  
that my said son John Joseph his Executors & admors  
will permit my son Lemuel to use & enjoy the said  
land & negroes & their increase during the term of his  
natural life & at his death that my said son John  
or his executors or admors will divide the same  
between the wife & children of my son Lemuel in  
the same manner as the same would be divided &  
distributed by law in the event of the death of my  
son Lemuel intestate seized & possessed in his own  
right of said property.

Item I give & devise to my son Gran A. Palmer  
the Temple's land whereon my son Robert now lives  
also all the negroes that I have heretofore placed in his  
possession & the increase of said negroes since he has  
had them in possession & the increase that they may here  
after have & to hold to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & devise to my son Robert M. Palmer  
the Thompson land on which I now live to have and  
hold to him & his heirs forever subject however to  
the life interest in one third part thereof herein before  
given to my wife I also give & bequeath to my son  
Robert the following negroes (to w<sup>ch</sup>) Duncan Bisset  
& her child Nancy & Lack & the increase they may  
hereafter have which negroes my son Robert has in his  
possession & in addition to them I give & bequeath to him  
a negro boy named Lovell now in my possession to have  
& to hold to him & his heirs forever

Item I ratify & confirm the gift I have here  
 tofore made by deed to my son in-law George  
 Goldston of all the negros that I have placed  
 in his possession & their increase

Item I give & bequath to my daughter Leticia  
 mus H. Alston all the negros that I have here  
 tofore placed in her possession & the increase  
 that they may hereafter have to have & to hold  
 to her & her heirs forever

Item I give & bequath to Martin Rush &  
 his Executors & Administrators negros Gueff & Sula  
 now in the possession of my daughter Mary Ann  
 Lutter & the increase of said negros since they have  
 been in her possession & the increase they may here  
 after have in special trust & confidence  
 that the said Rush will hold the said negros for  
 the <sup>and use</sup> sole use & benefit of my daughter Mary  
 Ann Lutter during her natural life & at her  
 death the said Rush his Exor or Adm<sup>r</sup> will di-  
 -vide same among & between all the children  
 of my said daughter Mary Ann equally share  
 & share alike Item It is my will & desire that all  
 the rest of my property of every description not here  
 tofore disposd of remain with my wife during her  
 natural life & at her death it is my desire that  
 it be sold & that the proceeds thereof be distributed  
 as follows (viz) one seventh part to my son John  
 Joseph Palmer in trust for the benefit of my  
 son Samuel his wife & children in the same man-  
 ner as the property hereinbefore given to him in trust for  
 them

one seventh part to Martin Bush upon the same trust as the property herebefore given him in trust from my daughter Mary Ann & her children & one seventh part back to John Joseph Palmer son of Palmer Robert W. Palmer Scimus & Alston & George W. Goldston

In the name of God amen I Gabriel Utley being of sound mind and understanding and impressed with the great uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and being desirous to dispose of my Temporal affairs so that after my death no contention may arise relative to the same that I Gabriel Utley of the County and State aforesaid do make ordain publish and declare this my last will and testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made

First I bequeath my body to the dust whence it comes and my soul to God who gave it hoping for a happy immortality through the atoning merits of our Lord Jesus Christ the Saviour of the world my desire is that my body be buried in a neat and Christian like manner

Secondly that all my just debts be paid out of the proceeds of such property as shall hereinafter direct to be sold

Thirdly I doan unto my wife Lucy Utley during her natural life or widowhood the following property to wit Slave Mary and child Amy also my plantation with the exception of one hundred as hereinafter named with such farm machinery Tools as she may see fit with Two beds Frames & covering one side board & cupboard candle stand crockery & glass ware of every description with all the kitchen furniture 2<sup>nd</sup> choice Table & all the Shavers
