horses and two cow and Calves, one table and stool
my Bedding furniture and one year support or
provision during her natural life or widowhood
2nd Item, I also give to my son Robert Sears one negro
boy by the name of Nathan to him & his heirs
forever —

3rd Item I give to my daughter Lamprey Howard one
oxen girl by the name of Caroline one Bed &
furniture one Cow & calf to her & her heirs forever
4th Item — I give unto my daughter Nelly McDonald
thirty dollars out of my estate or the lawful sum
of her body and the balance of my estate after paying

I Sally Masay of the County of Charlotte and State of North
Carolina being of sound mind & memory here consider-
ing the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make
this my last will & testament in manner & form
following viz. I give & bequeath to Calvin Johnson son
of Solomon one hundred & fifty acres of Land to be run off
on the north of my land, Item, I give & bequeath to Solomon
Johnson all the remainder of my land. I also give & bequeath

revoking & declaring utterly void all other wills & testa-
ments by me heretofore made in writing whereof I should
