tho it had not been given away. Item second I do give to
Samuel Templemon my second son bid and furniture one horse
bridle and saddle and one choice cow and calf and twenty five
dollars to be paid him and his brother Aspin to raise that money
at the expiration of six months and if the said Samuel
Templemon shall never personally apply for the said money
and property then and in that case it is to be as tho never
given to him I do hereby confirm the gifts of property that
my son James Linsbury has had of me before this date with the
the desire that he have one more choice cow and calf and my
shop business to be immediately after my death and at the
death of my wife or marriage he is to have my negro man Raleigh
Item 4th I do give to my daughter Martha an one
negro girl by the name of Penny and all of her increase and
one bid bedstead and furniture one cow and calf and
horse by the by the name of doles bridle and saddle more
the up the above named property of the said Martha is
to remain at her mothers until she shall have her said
mother Item 5th I do give to my son Cheswonus a salary
one small filly by the name of Henry Bridle and saddle
one cow and calf one bid and furniture and at the

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death or marriage of my wife or marriage he is to have all of my land and
barrels and stands and smaller things that belongs to the taxump
making side and I do also give him my gun. The property above
named or given to my youngest son Cohesious Sabury is to
remain at my house untill he shall be of age or untill the
death of his mother or marriage, I do now lend to my dear wife
during her life time or widow hood the use of all my land
the use of all the crop of every kind and all of my farming tools
waggon and gear, still stands and barrels, household and kitchen
furniture with all of my cows horses hogs & sheep not given
away above, and at the death of my wife or her becoming
married, my wish is that all of the property so lent except
what is given away I wish to be equally divided between my
three living children, with this exception that my sons
Joshua and Samuel Simplicon is to have no more than that
given to them in the two first shares, and if my wife should
marry or it should appear that she was wasting the
property so lent then and in that case, I give her
a makey and one bed and furniture to do with as she may think
fit and if either of my children should die before and not
leave a lawful heir the property will to them is to be
equally divided as directed above, Lastly I do hereby appoint
my wife and my son James Duesbury Broker Executor
and Executor to this my last will and Testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal in the year of our Lord 1830.
