

I Sarah Swain of the County of Cumberland
State of North Carolina being by sound & disposing
mind & memory, revoking all wills by me hitherto made,
do make, ordain, publish & declare, this to be my last
will & Testament as now and from following day: - I hereby
constitute my son John Swain & his son Frederick J. Swain
both of the County of Moore State aforesaid & the survivor
of them, Executor and Executrix of this my last Will & Testament
After the payment of my just debts & charges I dispose
of my Estate as follows:

I give and bequeath unto my said Executrix and the
survivor of them and to the Executor, or Executrix, Adminis-
trator or administrator of such survivor the follow-
ing Negra Slaves, viz. Nick Henry, Joseph William
Sam, Hamibal, Ned, Nancy, Mary Ann, Rachel
Kitty, Clara, and her two daughters Sally & Nelly and
& her three sons William Henry, Jim & Gosh; to have
to hold the same to the uses and trusts following, to wit,
for the sole separate use and benefit of my daughter
Ann Sophia Swain, (exclusive of the fees & maintenance
of her present Husband Frederick J. Swain or of any future
husband) and of her children Sarah, Betsy, Ann,
James, Samuel and William ^{living} then and then hereafter
again forever. And I hereby authorize and empower my
said Executrix or either of them to hire out the said slaves to
receive the money for the same for the use & benefit of my said
daughter & her children Ann Sophia Swain & her children after-
said & to exercise a general control & direction of said
slaves in such way as shall seem best to them or the
survivor thereof, & his Executor or Executrix, Administrator
or administrator for the interest of the said Ann Sophia
Swain & her said children for and during the minority
of my grandson the said William Swain and then
he arrives at the age of twenty one years, or in the
event of his death before that period, then upon
the arrival of lawful age (twenty one years) of the
then youngest surviving child, all of the said slaves
& the increase of the same are to be equally divided
among, & the children then living, that is to say the
children herein mentioned & no others, of their mother
& alive share and share alike in addition to the

above mentioned property I give and devise unto my said
Executors & to the Survivor of them & to the Executors or Executrix
Administrator or Administrator of such Survivor my
plantation in Cumberland County, in special trust & confi-
dence however for the sole and exclusive use & benefit of
my said daughter in law Ann Sophia Swain & her chil-
dren herein before mentioned & to no others, exclusive of the
fee & maintenance of her present husband or any future husband,
to be occupied & possessed by her & her said children as a
home as their common property, provided however that if
my said daughter in law shall refuse & decline to reside on
my said plantation after my death, that all right & interest
hereby given & devised to my Executrix, for the use & benefit
of her & her said children shall cease and end, and in the
event that my said Daughter in law Ann Sophia Swain should
refuse to reside upon said plantation, then in that event I
give & devise the aforesaid plantation together with an old
granary house & the stock on said plantation to my
grandson Frederick J. Swain (son of my son & his wife)
and his heirs forever. Should the said Ann Sophia Swain however
reside on my plantation then I also give & bequeath to my said
Executor the said Negro Sam & the stock on the plantation with
the same trusts and limitations as mentioned above with
reference to the other property, for the benefit of the said
Ann Sophia Swain & her children.

All the residue of my property of every description (except
two negro women Beck & Sandy & the children which they now
have and their future increase none of which do I design to
give to anyone) I give and bequeath to the children of my
daughter Mrs. Mariah Doornan & of my son John Swain
to be equally divided among them share and share alike.
In witness whereof I have this 28th day of January A. D. 1845 to
this, my last will & Testament as aforesaid made & signed by me
signed sealed published & declared by the above named testatrix Sarah *Sarah Swain*
Swain as for her last will & Testament in the
presence of us, who at her request are in her presence, and in the presence
of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses thereto.
