heirs in fee simple forever - Item - I give & devise to
my fourth daughter Susannah Craven wife of Ed. Craven

all that tract of land whereon I now live to have & to hold her
 & her heirs in fee simple forever -
 Item - My will & desire is that all the moneys of my estate (if any)
 after paying out the debts above mentioned shall be sold and
 the debts owing to me collected and if there should be any surplus
 over and above the payment of debts and expenses, that
 such surplus shall be sold and equally divided &
 paid over to my four daughters in equal proportion
 share and share alike to them and each & every of them -
 their executor administrators & assigns absolutely forever.
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my three youngest sons
 in law Joseph Hysen Eli Brown & Uriah Henry my
 lawful Executors to all intents & purposes to execute this
 my last Will & Testament according to the true intent & meaning
 of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revok-
 ing and declaring utterly void all other wills & Testaments
 by me heretofore made in writing whereof I the said
